

How to backwash

DE & Sand filters



Backwash hose



Multi-Port Valve

Step 1: Roll out blue backwash hose to designated area.

Step 2: Turn system OFF

Step 3: Place multiport valve handle to backwash position.

Step 4: Turn system on watch site glass where water flows by until it becomes a clear color.

Step 5: Turn system OFF

Step 6: Place multiport valve to rinse position.

Step 7: Turn system on watch site glass where water flows by until it becomes a clear color.

Step 8: Turn system OFF

Step 9: Place multiport handle to filter position.

Step 10: Turn system ON

Step 11: Roll blue backwash hose up to store for next use.

Step 12: If you have a DE FILTER place 3lbs (3 orange scoops) into skimmer.

Step 13: You may have to repeat steps 2-7 a few times.

Filtering:

The filter should run a minimum of 12 continuous hours a day. It is more helpful if these 12 hours are during the daylight, when a more economical load will be put into your pool. Inadequate filtration is one of the most common causes of cloudy water. The filter media should be chemically cleaned every 6-8 weeks for chlorine or bromine and every 4-6 weeks for SoftSwim.
