

Caring for your swimming pool & protecting your investment



- The filtration system is reccomended to run 24 hours per day to maintain the best water quality.
- When you turn off the filtration system, you also turn off your pool's ability to sanitize & heat the water.

NOTE: your pool's start-up PSI on the filter guage. When PSI increases I Opsi over the start up or when water flowing from the returns feels weak...it is time to backwash or chemically clean the filter media to improve water flow. Stagnant water will most likely have a clarity or algae issue. Surfaces can become slippery and produce unsafe swim conditions.

You should physically clean the pool 1-2 times per week depending on use.

Brush the walls, stairs, water line, vacuum, empty the skimmer & pump baskets.

Weekly water testing & adjustments to the water will help avoid major clarity issues of the pool.

Below are the most common side affects for unbalanced water:

- Low chlorine will bloom algae & be
- High chlorine & unbalanced PH may cause skin irritation & make your liner more suscpetible to wrinkling & fading
- Low ALK will damage the heat exchanger of the pool's heater







Equipment life expectancy and upkeep



Filters: Cartridge, Earth, and Sand

Overall life expectancy is 7-10 years with regular care (general replacement of wearable parts is normal).

- **☆** Grids/Cartridges 2-4 years (2 x year chemical cleaning)
- % O-rings & Gaskets may need to be replaced to prevent leaks



Cartridge Filter See more at Pentair.com

- Must rinse cartridges monthly with garden hose
- Chemical clean filter at least 2 x per season or after a major clarity clean up



Earth Filter See more at Pentair.com

- Routinely backwash to expel trapped debris in housing
- Rinse grids as needed with garden hose
- Chemically clean grid twice per season or after major clarity clean up



Sand Filter See more at Pentair.com

- Change sand every 2-3 years or as needed
- Chemically clean sand at least 1x per season or after major clarity clean up

Mid-Season Filter Cleaning \$110.00 (Reg. \$150.00)

- Rinse off filter grids or cartridges
- Inspect & note repairs if needed
- Chemical Clean

Heater See more at Pentair.com

Good care is balancing water chemistry weekly to prevent damage to the exchanger, completing a heater tune up & maintenance of pool heater yearly, and proper winterization. Normal life expectancy is 7-10 years with regular care.

• Excessively warming pool water can make the pool liner more susceptible to liner wrinkling.

Heater Tune Up & Maintenance: \$150.00 (Reg. \$175.00) – parts & labor for repairs are not included.

- Check heater for leaks & operation
- Clean corroded electrical connections
- Clean heat exchanger of debris*
- Clean pilot & ignitor*
- Set max temp if no spa (90°)*

- Clean burner & injectors of deposits & spider webs*
- Clean out cabinet of all debris
- Check & adjust gas pressure
- Inspect venting
- Inspect unitherm regulator *

Protect your investment to protect your pocket book!

The auto cover is a great investment in your swimming pool to provide overall peace of mind. It keeps the pool safe from unwated debris, swimmers, & lowering your operating costs.

It is important to open the cover during the day a few times per week to allow the water to "breath or gas off." This lets contaminates that have entered the water to be removed from the pool through oxidation.

Below are a few suggestions for routine maintenance to keep your system operating smoothly.

- Rinse the tracks with a garden hose monthly to keep the tracks free of debris
- Remove all debris from the inside of the auto cover housing at the start of each season or as needed
- Remove large debris & water from the top of the cover prior to opening
- Gently "bump" the key switch when opening and closing of the cover when near 6"-12" of the end of the pool. This will help prevent damage to the stops & glides of the auto cover
- Clean the cover & apply vinyl protectant to cover yearly

- Wearable parts on the cover (ropes, slides, guides ect) are expected to last 2-3 years with regular upkeep and careful operation when in use.
- Cover material is expected to last 6-10 years with cleaning & vinyl protection
